**RE: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT**


Dear Mayor Williams:

On January 23, 2002, agents of this Office working with members of the Metropolitan Police Department's Special Investigations Branch, Auto Theft Unit, arrested Marliyn Joyce Riley, an employee of the District of Columbia Department of Motor Vehicles, for allegedly taking surrendered D.C. license plates and converting them for use on her personal motor vehicle. Riley was charged with Second Degree Theft, Driving Without a Permit and Driving an Unregistered Auto.

On March 19, 2002, Riley pled guilty before Judge Stephen Milliken of the Superior Court in Washington, D.C. In addition to losing her employment with the Department of Motor Vehicles, Riley received four months of supervised probation and was required to pay \$50 to the District of Columbia Victim Fund.
