RE: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Williams:

This report is to inform you of an investigation conducted by Special Agent Karen Meunier of this Office concerning Lisa Strickland, a former D.C. Office of Finance and Treasury employee assigned to the Department of Motor Vehicles.

On April 15, 2005, Strickland pled guilty to a pattern of accepting bribe payments in exchange for issuing motor vehicle registrations, tags, vehicle titles, and overriding unpaid tickets. As a result of her actions, the District of Columbia lost in excess of \$200,000. On August 5, 2005, Strickland was sentenced by United States District Court Judge Rosemary M. Collyer to 18 months imprisonment, followed by 2 years of supervised release. Collyer also ordered that Strickland pay \$200,000 in restitution to the D.C. government.
