RE: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Williams:

This report is to inform you of an investigation conducted by Special Agent Karen Meunier of this Office concerning Vincent Greenidge, a District of Columbia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) employee, for a bribery scheme that took place at the DMV's Georgetown Park Branch.

Greenidge, a Clerk assigned to the Georgetown Park Branch, provided driver's licenses in fraudulent names to individuals who were recruited by two civilians, Craig Hughes and Gregory Murray. Hughes and Murray would arrange to meet with individuals who would pay between \$1,500 and \$1,800 for each fraudulent driver's license. They would then escort the individuals to meet with Greenidge, who processed the licenses in exchange for payment. (In August 2004, Lisa Johnson, a District of Columbia Office of the Chief Financial Officer employee, Hughes, and Murray were arrested on bribery charges relating to this investigation).

Greenidge was charged with bribery, and on January 10, 2005, he pled guilty in federal court to receiving bribes. Greenidge will be sentenced on March 15, 2005, and faces 10 to 16 months of imprisonment. On August 26, 2004, Greenidge was terminated from employment for unrelated administrative issues.
