RE: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Williams:

This report is to inform you of the results of an investigation that was conducted by Special Agent Denmark Slay, D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG), concerning Judith Jamison, a former District of Columbia Public Schools teacher, and the niece of an annuitant of the Office of Pay and Retirement Services, Office of the Chief Financial Officer.

This investigation revealed that after the death of Jamison's aunt, Jamison fraudulently obtained \$31,782 in annuity payments by telephonically transferring the monthly payment from her aunt's sole signatory account to an account on which Jamison and her aunt were co-signatories. In addition, after her aunt's death, Jamison presented checks for payment that were drawn on her aunt's account bearing the signature of her deceased aunt.


On December 23, 2005, a grand jury of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia formally charged Jamison with one count of Theft of Government Property and one count of Fraud in the First Degree. On this same date, an arrest warrant was issued for Jamison.

On March 10, 2006, Jamison entered a guilty plea to one count of Theft of Government Property. On May 31, 2006, she will be sentenced before the Honorable Reggie Walton, United States District Court for the District of Columbia.
