
This report is to inform you of the results of an investigation that was conducted by Special Agent Thomas Trimble, of this Office, concerning Jason D. Johnson, an employee of the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and a claimant with the D.C. Office of Personnel (DCOP).

This investigation revealed that Johnson fraudulently obtained health insurance benefits in the amount of \$8,914.69 for his fiancée while he was married and listed as a dependant on his wife's District government employee's health insurance.

On June 15, 2005, Johnson pled guilty before The Honorable Mary Ellen Abrecht, Judge, District of Columbia Superior Court, to one count of False Representation and agreed to make a restitution payment of \$3,600. Johnson will repay DCOP \$100 a month for the next 36 months commencing on July 1, 2005, and ending on June 1, 2008. Johnson's sentencing was deferred pending the successful repayment of the funds to DCOP. If Johnson fails to adhere to the Deferred Sentencing Agreement, he faces a maximum sentence of 1 year and a \$100,000 fine.
