RE: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Williams:

This report is to inform you of the results of an investigation that was conducted by Special Agent Thomas Trimble, District of Columbia Office of the Inspector General (OIG), concerning allegations of employee misconduct by John M. Wilson, an employee of the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS).

This investigation revealed that on December 23, 2005, while working in the DCPS mailroom located at 825 North Capitol Street, Northeast, Washington, D.C., Wilson wrongfully removed a \$5,250 check issued by the Devereux Foundation to the DCPS, and deposited the check into his personal checking account at PNC Bank.

On May 16, 2006, Wilson pled guilty before the Honorable Lynn Leibovitz, Associate Judge, Superior Court of the District of Columbia, to one count of Second Degree Theft, in violation of D.C. Code § 22-3211, and agreed to make restitution in the amount of \$5,250.

On June 12, 2006, Wilson appeared before Judge Leibovitz and, in accordance with D.C. § 22-3212(b), was sentenced to 120 days incarceration (with all 120 days suspended), 1 year supervised probation, 40 hours of community service, and \$50 in court costs. Wilson had previously made full restitution to DCPS.
