RE: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Fenty:

This report is to inform you of the results of an investigation that was conducted by Special Agent Bernadette Todd-Atwater, District of Columbia Office of the Inspector General (OIG), concerning allegations of time and attendance fraud committed against the District of Columbia Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO) by Jacqueline R. Fripp, a former Dynamix Corporation (Dynamix) contract employee.

This investigation revealed that between January 2004 and September 2004, Ms. Fripp submitted timesheets containing approximately 2,033 fraudulent hours to Dynamix, an OCTO contractor. As a result, she was compensated between \$70,805 and \$135,315 for hours she did not work. Dynamix previously reimbursed the District government \$125,000, pursuant to a settlement agreement with OCTO, for consideration of the funds fraudulently obtained by Ms. Fripp.


On August 31, 2007, Ms. Fripp was convicted in the Superior Court of the District of Columbia of 13 counts of False Representation. *See* D.C. Code § 2-308.21.

On October 31, 2007, the Honorable Russell F. Canan sentenced Ms. Fripp to 30 days incarceration, which was suspended except 2 days; 100 hours of community service; and 3 years probation. In addition, Ms. Fripp was ordered to pay \$11,411.60 in restitution, of which 25% will be deposited into the Office of the Attorney General Anti-Fraud Fund, and an additional fine of \$650 to be paid to the Victims of Violent Crimes Fund.
