RE: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Fenty:

This report is to inform you of the results of an investigation conducted by Special Agent Thomas Trimble of this Office and Special Agent Michelle Rankin of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, concerning Narase Bob Oudit, a former employee of the District of Columbia Office of Property Management (OPM).

This investigation revealed that Oudit (while working as an engineer for OPM) solicited bribes from three separate contractors who were working on the Turkey Thicket and North Michigan Park Recreation Centers. Oudit demanded in excess of \$290,000 in this bribery scheme.

On February 22, 2006, a federal grand jury indicted Oudit for ten-counts of Extortion, Bribery and honest services fraud.


On July 28, 2006, Oudit pled guilty before U.S. District Court Judge Paul L. Friedman to one count of Bribery, a felony in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 201 (b) 2 (a).

On May 18, 2007, Oudit appeared before Judge Friedman, and was sentenced to 37 months incarceration with the Bureau of Prisons and ordered to pay a \$100 special assessment fee. Upon completion of his incarceration, Oudit will serve 2 years of supervised probation.
