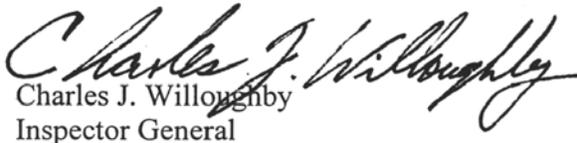
This report is to inform you of the recent sentencing of Michael A. Clark, a private citizen, who assisted Jacqueline Wright, a Revenue Officer in the Office of the Chief Financial Officer, Office of Tax and Revenue (OTR), in obtaining \$184,021.03 in tax refunds by filing a fraudulent 2006 D.C. income tax return.

On August 26, 2008, Mr. Clark pled guilty to one count of Mail Fraud, and on October 21, 2008, was sentenced to 6 months in a halfway house and 4 years of probation. In addition, Mr. Clark was ordered to pay \$184,000 in restitution and to perform 200 hours of community service.

The investigation, conducted by former Special Agent Thomas Gibson of the D.C. Office of Inspector General (OIG) working jointly with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, revealed that Ms. Wright filed a fictitious 2006 D.C. income tax return for Mr. Clark, which resulted in the issuance of six fraudulent tax refund checks totaling \$184,021.03. Mr. Clark and Ms. Wright shared this money. The scheme would have continued unabated for the 2007 tax year had OTR not established a new policy mandating the flagging and review of income tax refunds in excess of \$10,000.
