**Re: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT**


Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on January 24, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Brittany Davis, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), 3 year of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the court ordered Ms. Davis to pay restitution in the amount of \$18,908.

Special Agent Michele Carter of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from August 2009 through February 2012, Ms. Davis fraudulently obtained \$18,908 in unemployment insurance benefits, to which she was not entitled, while working for Compass Group USA. After the investigation, on November 4, 2013, Ms. Davis pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
