**Re: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT**


Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on February 14, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Mary Black, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), 3 years of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of probation for defrauding the District Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Ms. Black to pay restitution in the amount of \$22,740.

Special Agent Bernadette Todd of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from September 2008 through January 2012, Ms. Black fraudulently obtained \$22,740 in unemployment insurance benefits to which she was not entitled, while working for Aramark Services. After the investigation, on January 14, 2014, Ms. Black pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
