This report is to inform you of the recent sentencing of Shelly Wicker, a former District government employee, who received bribes from John Craul, a member of the public, for forging signatures on Office of Tax and Revenue documents.


The investigation was conducted by Special Agent Michele Carter, D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG). The investigation revealed that Ms. Wicker received bribes from Mr. Craul for forging her supervisor's signature on tax credit certificates for businesses associated with Mr. Craul that resulted in a loss of \$106,232.00 to the District government.

On November 19, 2010, Ms. Wicker pled guilty to Bribery. On February 17, 2011, Ms. Wicker was sentenced to 5 years of probation, payment of \$106,232.00 in restitution, and 200 hours of community service.

On November 19, 2010, Mr. Craul pled guilty to Supplementation of Salary. On February 17, 2011, Mr. Craul was sentenced to 3 years of probation, a fine of \$2,500.00, and 2,000 hours of community service.
