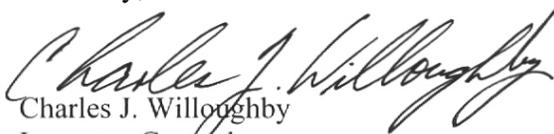
This report is to inform you of the recent plea and sentencing of Annternet Howard, who engaged in a scheme to negotiate stolen District and U.S. Treasury checks, by using fraudulent forms of government identification bearing the names, addresses, and dates of birth of the intended recipients of the checks.

On September 7, 2010, Ms. Howard pled guilty to Conspiracy to Commit Mail Fraud. On December 10, 2010, Ms. Howard was sentenced to 30 days of incarceration (12 weekends), 180 days of electronic home monitoring, 36 months of supervised probation, and payment of \$12,508.65 in restitution.

The investigation was conducted jointly by Senior Special Agent Derek Savoy, D.C. Office of the Inspector General, Postal Inspector Christopher Saunders, U.S. Postal Inspection Service, Special Agent Levar Perkins, United States Secret Service, and Special Agent Karma Knight, U.S. Postal Service Office of the Inspector General. The investigation revealed that between May 2008 and February 2010, Ms. Howard fraudulently negotiated District and U.S. Treasury checks totaling \$12,508.65.
