
This report is to inform you of the recent plea and sentencing of Stacey Cosey, a member of the public, who fraudulently obtained Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits from the D.C. Department of Employment Services.

On December 10, 2010, Ms. Cosey pled guilty to First Degree Fraud and was sentenced to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), 5 years of supervised probation, and payment of \$13,910.00 in restitution.

The investigation, which was conducted by Special Agent Michele Carter, D.C. Office of the Inspector General, revealed that Ms. Cosey fraudulently obtained UI benefits while privately employed in Maryland. During the period of May 2008 to March 2009, Ms. Cosey fraudulently received \$13,910.00 in UI benefits.
