RE: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Fenty:

This report is to inform you of the recent plea and sentencing of Benevenuto Bullock, a D.C. Department of Youth Rehabilitation Services (DYRS) employee, who fraudulently obtained Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits from the D.C. Department of Employment Services.

On September 13, 2010, Mr. Bullock pled guilty to First Degree Fraud and was sentenced to 90 days incarceration (suspended), 27 months of supervised probation, and payment of \$7,956.00 in restitution.

The investigation, which was conducted by Special Agent Michele Carter, D.C. Office of the Inspector General, revealed that Mr. Bullock fraudulently obtained UI benefits while employed full time for DYRS. During the period of October 2007 to November 2009, while employed with DYRS, Mr. Bullock fraudulently received \$7,956.00 in UI benefits.
