
Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on August 26, 2011, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Eric Y. Lee, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), 3 years of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of supervised probation, for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Mr. Lee to pay \$12,545 in restitution.

Special Agent Anthony McGail of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from February 2008 to October 2008, Mr. Lee fraudulently obtained \$12,545 in Unemployment Insurance benefits while privately employed. After the investigation, on June 7, 2011, Mr. Lee pled guilty to Fraud in the First Degree.
