
This report is to inform you of the recent plea and sentencing of Karen Wimbush, an employee of the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE), who fraudulently obtained Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits from the D.C. Department of Employment Services.

On September 24, 2010, Ms. Wimbush pled guilty to First Degree Fraud and was sentenced to 180 days incarceration (suspended), 5 years of probation, and payment of \$5,803.00 in restitution.

The investigation, which was conducted by Special Agent Michele Carter, D.C. Office of the Inspector General, revealed that Ms. Wimbush fraudulently obtained UI benefits while employed with OSSE. During the period of June 2006 to December 2006, Ms. Wimbush fraudulently received \$5,803.00 in UI benefits.
