
This report is to inform you of the recent plea and sentencing of Anurak Duangphut, a former employee of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG), who falsely stated on documents submitted to the D.C. government when applying for her job that she was a D.C. resident.

On May 10, 2010, Ms. Duangphut pled guilty to False Statements. On July 30, 2010, Ms. Duangphut was sentenced to 180 days of incarceration (suspended), 12 months of probation, 100 hours of community service, and payment of \$3,403.44 in restitution.

The investigation revealed that on a job application filed December 13, 2007, and a Residency Preference Form submitted with her application, Ms. Duangphut stated that she was a D.C. resident. Ms. Duangphut, in fact, resided in Maryland. Ms. Duangphut was hired to work at the OIG as a Staff Assistant, effective March 17, 2008. She was terminated from her position, effective March 29, 2010.
