
This report is to inform you of the recent plea and sentencing of Jima Christopher Henry, a member of the public, who fraudulently obtained Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits from the D.C. Department of Employment Services.

The investigation, which was conducted by Special Agent Emily Hosenbackez, D.C. Office of the Inspector General, revealed that Mr. Henry fraudulently obtained UI benefits during the period of January 2008 to December 2008, while privately employed in Washington, D.C.

On January 13, 2011, Mr. Henry pled guilty to First Degree Fraud and was sentenced on April 8, 2011, to 12 months of incarceration (suspended), 3 years of supervised release (suspended), 4 years of supervised probation, and payment of \$13,608 in restitution.
