
This report is to inform you of the recent plea and sentencing of Johanna Folake Fapohunda, a former Office of the State Superintendent of Education employee.

The investigation, which was conducted by investigators from the D.C. Office of the Inspector General and U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement, revealed that Ms. Fapohunda falsified part of her employment application (Employment Eligibility Verification) by representing that she was a United States citizen and was authorized to work in the United States when, in fact, she was not.

On January 26, 2011, Ms. Fapohunda pled guilty to False Personation of a United States Citizen. On May 4, 2011, Ms. Fapohunda was sentenced to 24 months of probation, 50 hours of community service, and a fine of \$250.
