RE: **SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT**


Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on March 22, 2013, a U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia judge sentenced Viola Davies, a Maryland resident, to 180 days of incarceration (180 days suspended), and 3 years of probation for receiving stolen property from D.C. Public Schools. In addition, the court ordered Ms. Davies to pay \$35,529 in restitution.

Special Agent Emily Hosenbackez of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from August 2006 through June 2010, Ms. Davies fraudulently received \$35,529 in tuition benefits to which she was not entitled because she lived in Maryland. After the investigation, on December 21, 2012, Ms. Davies pled guilty to one misdemeanor count of Receiving Stolen Property.
