Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on March 23, 2012, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced James Ellis Evans, a member of the public, to 90 days of incarceration (suspended), 1 year of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of supervised probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Mr. Evans to pay \$12,582 in restitution.

Special Agent Emily Hosenbackez of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from March 2008 through December 2008, Mr. Evans fraudulently obtained \$12,582 in unemployment insurance benefits while employed. After the investigation, on December 12, 2011, Mr. Evans pled guilty to Fraud in the First Degree.
