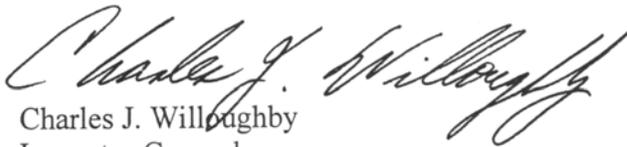
Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on November 29, 2011, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Adriane Fisher, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended) and 18 months of supervised probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services.

Special Agent Michele Carter of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from September 2009 through January 2011, Ms. Fisher fraudulently obtained \$20,995.00 in unemployment insurance benefits while employed. After the investigation, on August 30, 2011, Ms. Fisher pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the First Degree. Ms. Fisher repaid the \$20,995.00 to the District just before she pled guilty.
