
Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on October 28, 2011, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Collette Reynolds, a member of the public, to 8 months of incarceration (suspended), 1 year of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Ms. Reynolds to pay \$15,475.00 in restitution.

Senior Special Agent Derek Savoy of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from November 2006 through November 2009, Ms. Reynolds fraudulently obtained \$15,475 in unemployment insurance benefits while employed. After the investigation, on August 22, 2011, Ms. Reynolds pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the First Degree.
