
Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on November 16, 2011, a United States District Court judge sentenced Charles White, a former District government employee, to 24 months of probation. In addition, the court ordered Mr. White to pay a \$250 fine.

Senior Special Agent Derek Savoy of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that on or about August 9, 2008, Mr. White received a check in the amount of \$20,300 from a company owned by his friend, in exchange for Mr. White selecting the friend's company to perform renovation work for the District of Columbia Public Schools. After the investigation, on August 22, 2011, Mr. White pled guilty to one count of Supplementation of Government Salary.
