
Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on August 21, 2013, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Antoyne Mitchell, a member of the public, to 3 months of supervised probation (suspended) and 5 years of probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the court ordered Mr. Mitchell to pay \$14,099 in restitution.

Special Agent Stephen Eggleston of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from September 2008 to August 2009, Mr. Mitchell fraudulently obtained \$14,099 in unemployment insurance compensation benefits while employed. After the investigation, on June 18, 2013, Mr. Mitchell pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
