Re: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Bowser:

This letter is to inform you that on June 24, 2015, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Anthony J. Motley, an employee of the D.C. Public Schools (DCPS), to 8 months of incarceration (suspended), 1 day of supervised release (suspended), and 2 years of probation for defrauding the District government of grant funds. In addition, the court ordered Mr. Motley to complete 200 hours of community service and pay restitution in the amount of \$52,063.

The D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) investigation revealed that from November 2008 through November 2009, Mr. Motley diverted \$52,063 in District grant funds intended for a non-profit organization by issuing checks to himself or to organizations that he controlled. On April 29, 2015, Mr. Motley pled guilty to one count of felony fraud in the first degree.
