Re: Significant Activity Report

Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on October 23, 2013, the Honorable Heidi Pasichow, Associate Judge, District of Columbia Superior Court, sentenced Antoine Wright, a member of the public, to 9 months incarceration (suspended), 3 years of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the court ordered Mr. Wright to pay restitution in the amount of \$17,315.

Special Agent Michael Montgomery of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from August 2010 through August 2011, Mr. Wright received \$17,950 in unemployment insurance compensation benefits for which he was ineligible. Mr. Wright subsequently made payments totaling \$635, thus reducing the amount of restitution to \$17,315. On October 9, 2013, Mr. Wright pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree, a felony.
