Re: **Significant Activity Report**

Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on January 9, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Donna Queen, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), and 5 years of supervised probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Ms. Queen to pay restitution in the amount of \$18,203 as a condition of her probation.

Special Agent Alex Zion of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG), along with the U.S. Department of Labor OIG, conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from September 2007 through March 2010, Ms. Queen fraudulently obtained \$18,203 in unemployment insurance benefits while working for the Marriott Corporation. After the investigation, on October 30, 2013, Ms. Queen pled guilty to one count of Felony Fraud in the Second Degree.
