Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on November 22, 2013, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Lorraine Gorman, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), 3 years of supervised release (suspended), and 5 years of probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the court ordered Ms. Gorman to pay restitution in the amount of \$19,465.

Special Agent Michele Carter of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from November 2008 through March 2010, Ms. Gorman fraudulently obtained \$19,465 in unemployment insurance benefits while working for the Hyatt Corporation. After the investigation, on September 16, 2013, Ms. Gorman pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
