
This report is to inform you of the recent sentencing of Rhonda Dale Robinson, who fraudulently received unemployment benefits from the D.C. Department of Unemployment Services (DOES) using social security numbers assigned to other persons.

The investigation was conducted by the D.C. Office of the Inspector General, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the U.S. Department of Labor Office of the Inspector General. Between November 2004 and September 2007, Ms. Robinson applied for and fraudulently received unemployment compensation benefits totaling \$77,680, using social security numbers assigned to others.

On June 1, 2009, Ms. Dale entered a plea of guilty to Theft of Public Money and Aggravated Identity Theft. On December 23, 2009, Ms. Robinson was sentenced to 50 months of incarceration, 3 years of supervised release, and ordered to pay \$77,680 in restitution.
