Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on September 22, 2011, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Antoinette Washington, a member of the public, to 4 months of incarceration (suspended), and 5 years of probation (1 year supervised), for defrauding the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE). In addition, the court ordered Ms. Washington to pay \$12,098 in restitution.

Special Agent Michael Montgomery of the D. C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from January 2009 through July 2010, Ms. Washington fraudulently obtained \$12,098 in childcare subsidies while employed. After the investigation, on July 26, 2011, Ms. Washington pled guilty to Fraud in the First Degree.
