Re: SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT

Dear Mayor Bowser:

This letter is to inform you that on May 19, 2016, a District Court of Maryland judge sentenced Gloria T. Wilson, a D.C. Office of the Chief Technology Officer employee, to 8 months of home confinement, 3 years of probation, and 100 hours of community service for theft of government property from the U.S. Social Security Administration (SSA). In addition, the court ordered Ms. Wilson to pay restitution in the amount of \$176,874.

The joint D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) and SSA Office of the Inspector General investigation revealed that from November 1996 through January 2014, Ms. Wilson continued to receive SSA Survivor's Insurance benefits intended for her step-mother, after the step-mother's death on October 31, 1996, and did not report the death to the SSA. On December 9, 2015, Ms. Wilson agreed to plead guilty to one count of theft of government property, in violation of Title 18 U.S.C. § 641.
