Re: Significant Activity Report

Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on November 28, 2011, a U.S. District Court judge sentenced Raynell Redd, a member of the public, to 12 months of incarceration (suspended) and 4 years of supervised probation. Ms. Redd fraudulently obtained child care subsidies from the D.C. Office of the State Superintendent of Schools (OSSE). In addition, the court ordered Ms. Redd to pay \$8,868.00 in restitution and to perform 120 of community service.

Special Agent Alex Zion of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that for the 2009-2010 school year, Ms. Redd fraudulently applied for and received \$8,868.00 in child care subsidies. On November 28, 2011, Ms. Redd pled guilty to Fraud in the First Degree.
