
Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on January 24, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Sean Pettus, a member of the public, to 12 months of incarceration (suspended), and 5 years of probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services (DOES). In addition, the court ordered Mr. Pettus to pay restitution in the amount of \$20,861.

Special Agent Michael Tenant of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from November 2008 through January 2012, Mr. Pettus fraudulently obtained \$20,861 in unemployment insurance compensation benefits, to which he was not entitled, while working for the Marriott Corporation. After the investigation, on November 13, 2013, Mr. Pettus pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
