Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on February 14, 2014, a District of Columbia Superior Court judge sentenced Charlene Adams, a member of the public, to 6 months of incarceration (suspended), and 5 years of supervised probation for defrauding the D.C. Department of Employment Services. In addition, the court ordered Ms. Adams to pay restitution in the amount of \$17,214.

Special Agent Michael Tenant of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG) conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from May 2010 through May 2011, Ms. Adams fraudulently obtained \$17,214 in unemployment insurance compensation benefits to which she was not entitled, while working for the National Trust for Historic Preservation. After the investigation, on December 16, 2013, Ms. Adams pled guilty to one count of Fraud in the Second Degree.
