Re: **Significant Activity Report**

Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on October 9, 2013, a United States District Court for the District of Columbia judge sentenced Keely Thompson, Jr., a member of the public, to 30 months of incarceration and 36 months of supervised release for improperly using grant funds awarded to Keely's District Boxing and Youth Center by the District of Columbia government. In addition, the court ordered Mr. Thompson to pay \$205,000 in restitution and a special assessment of \$100,000.

Special Agent John DiGravio of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that from February 2004 to January 2009, Mr. Thompson improperly used \$205,000 in grant funds to pay for gambling, cruises, and other personal expenses. After the investigation, on June 26, 2013, Mr. Thompson pled guilty to one count of Wire Fraud.
