RE: **SIGNIFICANT ACTIVITY REPORT**

Dear Mayor Gray:

This report is to inform you that on December 7, 2012, U.S. District Court Judge Anthony J. Trenga sentenced Jimmie Epps, a Department of Public Works employee, to 24 months of supervised probation, for passing counterfeit notes at a local department store. In addition, the court ordered Ms. Epps to pay \$900 in restitution.

Special Agent Stephen Eggleston of the D.C. Office of the Inspector General (OIG), along with agents of the U.S. Secret Service, conducted the investigation. The investigation revealed that on April 11, 2012, Ms. Epps was observed passing \$900 in counterfeit currency at a local department store, in an attempt to purchase merchandise. After the investigation, on August 9, 2012, Ms. Epps pled guilty to one count of Uttering Counterfeit Obligations or Securities.
